Weddings can be expensive and in Haiti most people can't find the extra money to make this dream come true. RHFH understands that the marriage commitment will strengthen families and recently began to help some of our staff by doing Bible studies on marriage and then helping them celebrate their big day. We are happy to announce that two staff members were able to get married this month with the help of some generous donors. This make 5 staff that have went through this program and been married. Pilgrim's Progress helps youth consider the path of a Christian life and helps guide them to make good choices. This book is translated into Kreyol and is one of the favorites among the teens of Cazale. Two classes with a total of 21 teens recently completed 6 weeks of classes on this topic and read through the book. Graduation was held in June and everyone that graduated received a Bible or songbook.

Paul Evens was 2 years old and weighed 17 pounds when he was admitted to our inpatient nutrition center. A donor sponsored his treatment which included medications, IV fluids, food, Medika Mamba, and lots of love. He spend 3 months months here recovering from malnutrition and sepsis. During that time he was very ill and there were many days that we were not sure that he would live. By the grace of God, he did! He went home this past month weighing 23 1/2 pounds, healthy, and happy. His mother will continue to follow in the clinic with him to make sure her remains healthy and continues to gain weight. **Thank you to all those that sponsor kids!**

With your help, 3086 patients were seen in clinic this month. There were 41 healthy newborns & 309 pregnant women receiving care. The malnutrition rate has slightly increased from 49% to 52% and there were 75 at-risk children put on the medika mamba outpatient program. There were 53 emergencies, 28 pts sutured, and 454 dressing changes. We were able to pray with 23 patients, counsel 31 people, and distribute 2730 pieces of literature. We rejoice that there were 6 people that accepted salvation.
