BONJOUR TOUT MOUN!!




CURRENT NEEDS & FUTURE PLANS

In an effort to raise funds, donations, and awareness to the work in Haiti, Zach & Gretchen will be returning to the states for speaking and fund raising. It is not in our nature to nag you for money. It is not our pleasure to always come to you with an outstretched hand asking for supplies. But, working as missionaries to the poorest country in our hemisphere, it is a *harsh reality*. We have gladly depleted family funds in order to continue the needed work here. We have done so with *no regrets*, knowing that our true riches cannot be stored up here on earth. If we had the money to fund the mission here, we would use it - we have used it. Now we are calling on our Christian family to *once again give*. Give of your finances. Give of your time. Give of your supplies. Give of yourself. It pains my heart to continually ask like a beggar to fund the work of Christ. But, the simple fact is that money is needed to buy medicine, fund schooling, keep the cars running, support pastors, fund operations, help with housing, feeding programs, and crusades. We can't promise anything in return, **but God has**. We have tried our best to keep you informed of the work - both our successes and our failures. *If you find the work here acceptable, support it. Be involved!* Many ask us of our needs

and wants, so we will just lay it all out for you in these next pages. If someone feels called to give to a certain area, please let us know. As before, if the funds don't come in we simply stop that work and direct our energy elsewhere. We, in no way want to be pushy or demanding in pressuring you to give. Yet, there is an enormous need. We just want you to be aware of the things we need to function more effectively in the ministry.

INCREASE IN MONTHLY GIVINGS


- As God continues to open doors, the financial needs of this ministry keep increasing. We are so thankful to our faithful supporters who keep this ministry functioning. After over 7 years on the field, we have regular supporters from 9 churches and 7 families. Enoch & Licia and Lori have support from 1 church and 2 families receiving about \$250-\$300 a month for living and ministry expenses. Please let us know if there are any churches, groups of individuals that would be interested in financially supporting this work. We would be glad to share our vision, experiences and answer questions while we're in the states. Let us work together to achieve His purpose.



SHIPPING & CUSTOMS

- Last year a D-4 CAT Dozer and CAT Grader were donated to the mission. The well drilling machine has been ready for a year and a half. We are also expecting to ship at least one container of humanitarian supplies this summer. Shipping and customs are expensive. To ship these donations, we believe it will be about **\$30,000**. Please be praying that God will grant us favor in shipping and with customs officials here in Haiti. God is able.

SUPPLIES - We hope you are already gathering items to distribute to the people of Haiti. Watch for sales, clip coupons. Many stores have an area where discontinued and marked down items are placed. Check it out. Keep your eyes and ears open and share the needs with family, friends, co-workers and church family. Have a drive to collect peanutbutter, powdered milk, diapers, soap, etc. Step out, you will be amazed what God will do. We don't have to wait until Thanksgiving or Christmas to reach out to those in need. Call us if you have donations. We plan to start working on packing in April and May while Gretchen is home. We may have some packing parties so call if you want to help the summer.





VEHICLES - We need to upgrade our vehicles. Cars suffer much abuse climbing rocky mountain and dirt roads here. With funds, we could buy the vehicles here or would be happy for donated ones to ship from the states. We are looking for 4x4 diesel vehicles and a 15 passenger diesel van to transport teams. Please let us know if you know of any possibilities.

PROPERTY FUND - We are still looking for funds to complete the financing of Phase I. A year ago, about half of the needed funds were raised and have remained in a bank account. If God leads you, be blessed and be apart of contributing to the **\$70,000** still needed to reach the goal.



 **DIGGING WELLS** - We are chomping at the bit to get the well drilling rig transported here. Next to the spiritual news of God's love and saving grace is the need for clean drinking water. Often water is contaminated as people bathe, wash their clothes, and water their animals from the same source. Cost of 1 well for a village approx. **\$5000.**

 **FOUNDATION FUND** -
God is leading us to start a foundation fund to fund the work here in Haiti. Since this is a ministry that will be functioning until Jesus returns, there is a need for a stronger financial base to support and continue the work and ministry.
