Hopefully, it will mean a decrease in our malnourished of cases children. In the past months, without rain, the percentages of severe malnutrition have been steadily increasing.

Along with increase comes increases in other sicknesses too. The lack of rain can have widespread damage in many aspects of living here in Haiti. The last few months have shown record of typhoid cases and malnouritrion. This past week there has been protesting everyday. The rain is good for the gardens, but can be difficult for some in the poorer sectoins of the city. dranage ditches are full of trash and sewage so the water just sits. This causes

an awful smell and increased mosquitos and malaria. Please continue to pray for the Haitians and for God to touch their souls.
