The mission here in Haiti currently has 1 run down, old pickup to run all the errands for 3 families and the Clinic and Rescue Center needs. This vehicle has served us well in the years that we have had it, but the hard roads and heavy loads have worn it down. It is under need of constant repair and very unreliable. We desperately need to buy a ***Toyota, heavy duty, 4x4*** truck to transport medicine, haul supplies, distribute humanitarian items, pick-up donated items, run errands, and getting around the country. We currently have \$5000 donated towards the truck. This is a HUGE answer to prayer and we are SO VERY THANKFUL for those that have given.
