## RHFH PRAYER REQUESTS





Haiti is enduring a difficult time of political discord and economic instability. Please lift up the people of Haiti and the ministry of Real Hope for Haiti in the following ways this month.

- 1. Pray peacemakers would rise up, wisdom for a pathway forward would emerge, and security would return to the communities throughout Haiti.
- 2. Pray political leaders, local and national, would make it their priority to advocate and make decisions that would protect those most vulnerable, especially children.
- 3. Pray commerce could resume, so farmers could transport their produce to market and families could provide for themselves. The fragile economy needs to strengthen, not weaken, to provide jobs for many who are eager to work.
- 4. Pray Haitian children and young people could return to school and continue their education, forging ahead towards a brighter future for Haiti.
- 5. Pray for leaders to be clear in their communication, sound in their decisions, and attentive as they listen to the population.
- 6. Pray police have courage and wisdom enforcing law and order.
- 7. Pray for medical professionals and facilities to find ways to sustain their life-saving services and help people in critical need. Pray their staff is safe traveling to and from work and that they would have the necessary medicines and resources needed to serve their patient populations.
- 8. Pray for local churches throughout Haiti to be a bright light for Christ during this challenging season. Pray God enables each believer to endure and demonstrate the hope that dwells in them.
- 9. Pray the God would hear the prayers of many faithful men and women rising from the hearts of the Haitian people, crying out for mercy and deliverance.
- 10. Pray against the enemy, satan, who would want to come and destroy and discourage the Haitian people with doubt and despondence.

Specific prayers for Real Hope for Haiti:

- 1. Pray for our Haitian staff and their families, as school is suspended, prices of commodities continue to rise, fuel shortages are complicating the situation, the uncertainty is exhausting. One staff member who lives in PAP has not been able to return to her family since early September because of unsafe passage on the road. Pray God would strengthen them to continue to use the talents God has given them to serve the community of Cazale.
- 2. Pray that they, along with everyone in our community would be able to find the food, water, and resources they need during this season of instability.
- 3. Pray that our staff transporting supplies such as medicines, food, fuel, and patients would have safety as they travel and they would have doors opened for them to find what we need.
- 4. Pray prayers of thanksgiving that God has pieced everything we need together so far. One day we ran out of insulin at clinic, but a nurse who lives in a larger town was able to but 9 vials and bring to us the next day. God is providing and we are grateful.
- 5. Pray that our staff would not grow weary in well doing, but lean deeply into Christ who is the source of our strength.
- 6. Pray for wisdom, favor, unity, strength, and the creativity to continue to do what God has called us to Haiti to do no matter what the next days, weeks, or months bring. Pray we are faithful witnesses for Christ, no matter the cost.

We love you and are thankful for your consistency in praying for us and the work God has entrusted to us. Many medical facilities have had to drastically reduce their services or suspend them altogether due to the current crisis. But for the grace of God and the prayers of the saints, we would be in the same situation. Remain fervent in your prayers for the Haitian people. You have many brothers and sisters in the faith here who depend on you lifting them up to the Lord in prayer. Thank you!
