We are grateful for your faithful prayers for Haiti last month. While there is no final resolution the current political and economic issues plaguing Haiti, conditions have improved somewhat in the last five days. While there remains pockets of problems and instances of random violence, police have made concerted efforts in the past week to restore order in the streets and remove barricades when they pop up. Conditions are difficult to predict and can change rapidly, however, during this current reprieve, we are thankful to say that we were able to secure enough fuel and medicine to allow us to get through the end of the year without disruption to any of the life-sustaining services God enables us to provide.

Here are some ways you can pray for us and the people we serve this month:

1. Pray for continued peace and progress for the future of Haiti. Specifically, there is another potential political issue due to the fact that no elections were held in October due to unrest, and so, many terms will expire early in 2020, leaving the future uncertain.

2. Pray for the leaders of Haiti to have wisdom for decision making, clarity in their communication, and empathy and compassion for the many living on the margins here.

3. Pray for the students and teachers of Haiti that have missed over 2 months of school due to the recent protests. Pray for coordination to reorient and restart their school years.

4. Pray the police and newly reconstituted Haitian army will have courage to do what is right and just and to operate within the bounds of their authority.

5. Pray God would be good in helping farmers have a bountiful harvest to provide food for their communities and a means of income for their families.

Some specific patients you can pray for:

1. S.T.- She is married and does not yet have a child and feels a spiritual attack upon her. She asks for prayer for deliverance and freedom.

2. P.S.L- She has 6 kids and a husband and lives with her mother. She would like prayer that God would change their lives and they would turn and serve Him.

3. M.L.P- She had 6 kids, but one got sick and died. She feels under the influence of Satan and would like prayer that God would break that bondage.

4. G.A.- She has 8 children without a father. She would like prayer that God would help her to find work to support them.

5. D.C.- She has one child and would like prayer for deliverance from her suffering and injustice.

As always, we are thrilled to have so many people committed to pray for the people of Haiti and the work God has entrusted to us. Prayer has power, and despite the challenges of Haiti, we are reminded of God's power and providence often. We could not sustain this work without the prayers of God's people.
