We are grateful to report Haiti has continued to return to normal in the month of December. There are still sporadic problems, but peace largely returned to the streets and most people resumed their daily lives. It was a challenging few months since the unrest began. How quickly things turned is more evidence to us of the power of prayer. Glory be to God!

Here are some ways you can pray for us and the people we serve this month:

1. Pray for continued wisdom for the President and those in power as many currently serving in the Parliament will have their terms expire in early January, leaving the government unable to function. This will occur because previously scheduled elections never took place in October. Pray for a clear plan and communication of that plan so progress can continue.
2. Pray for our employees as many take their vacation over Christmas and the clinic is closed for general consultations the last week and first week of every year. Pray our staff, who work tirelessly, will be able to rest, recuperate, and be re-energized to begin another year of serving those who come through the gates of RHFH.
3. Pray for our chaplaincy program at RHFH. Our former chaplain relocated to Brazil, and we have three potential replacements shadowing a long-time partner of ours to attempt to re-imagine the program and increase its effectiveness.
4. Pray we would have favor and wisdom as we continue to grow in our services. One thing the Haitian government would like us to have is a Haitian doctor on staff. Because we are remote, it is difficult to find someone willing to make the effort to work for us. Please pray the Lord would bring the right person in the right time.
5. Pray for the Zachary family as they travel to Washington to spend the holidays with family. Pray for our teacher Anna, as she visits family in Alabama. Pray for the remainder of our staff that will remain in Haiti and continue to work diligently. The gang will be back together again in Cazale in early January.

Some specific prayer requests from patients at RHFH:

1. E.J.- Pray for his family and friends as they mourn his early death from cancer.
2. A.S. - Asks we pray for deliverance from satan's attacks as she feels satan is trying to steal all God has done for her.
3. J.J.O.- Asks we pray for him as he is a recent convert in trusting in Christ and has much to learn and change.
4. E.J.R.- Seeks prayer for severe problems in her life as an adversary in her community is constantly attacking her and making her life difficult, blocking her from advancing her life.
5. S.L.- Asks for prayer for her family because they have many problems and much bitterness and she desires them to have peace and unity.

We are thankful we have a God who is quick to hear our prayers and eager to answer them.
