1. Unfortunately, we have had two children abandoned at the clinic in January in separate situations. Please pray for both Nerphiou and Genelson. Both have been admitted to our Rescue Center. Pray we can find their families, educate their parents, find out how we can support them to keep these families together. Pray for wisdom and guidance as we navigate these respective situations.
2. Pray for J.L.S. who is asking for prayer for his wife who had a difficult labor and is sick and suffering.
3. V.M.J. asks you pray for her because she is feeling very attacked by the enemy and is discouraged. Pray that she might have strength in the Lord and persevere.
4. Pray for R.M.C. asks for prayer that the Lord will bless her in 2021 and she will see her life advance.
5. Please pray for C.P. asks for prayer for his children to have success in their education and in their life and have opportunities to find careers in the future.
6. C.J.L is a young lady needing prayer for severe anemia. She desires strength and healing.
7. E.P. is a lady who is requesting we lift her up in prayer that the pain all over her body will subside so she can continue to work and support her family.

Prayer requests for our work:

11. Pray for us as we plan and build a space out of shipping containers that will be the base for building projects on the new land, and then serve as a garage/workshop. We are excited about some progress we see coming together to develop new facilities on the land, but still need to figure out some issues such as water supply and other infrastructure. Pray God connects us to the right people and we find solutions for some of the problems impeding progress.
12. Pray for us and our board as we make a plan of execution for facilities on the new land and a clear voice to communicate them to our donors in the coming months.
13. Pray for our staff here in Haiti to collaborate well together and for the Haitian staff to be able to participate/ share ideas in developments on the new land.
14. Pray for protection for our workers/ patients as insecurity and kidnappings have ramped up in recent months here in Haiti. There are reports political unrest could intensify around February 7th. There have been intermittent fuel shortages and disruption in supplies.
15. Pray for our staff to remain diligent in COVID protocols. Numbers nationwide in Haiti have begun to rise again, however, we are thankful that we are not seeing a spike in our community.
16. Pray for our foster children. The foster parents to continue in their commitment to love and care for these children. Please pray for R., one of our foster children, who has had several seizures in the past week.
17. Please pray for our chaplains, each of which is teaching a three-month Bible class with young people in our village. Pray the teaching is clear and effective, turning hearts towards the Lord and helping many mature in their faith.

18. Pray for us as we dialogue with a long time volunteer who is potentially coming on staff this Spring. Pray communication with our board goes well, we can create a job description that is clear, and that she will bear a lot of fruit for the Lord through her work at Real Hope for Haiti, if it is the Lord's will she serve alongside us.
19. Prayers of Thanksgiving for Licia and Ameyah making it back to Haiti safely after setting Henley up to finish high school in Indiana. Pray for Henley to thrive and for doors to open for him and his future.
20. Pray for our teacher Anna who is wonderful and we miss dearly as she remains in the USA supporting her family during this season. Pray she is encouraged and feels the Lord near and is able to return to Cazale as soon as the Lord see fit.
21. Pray for Zach and Lorraine in MN as Lorraine continues to care for Zach. Also, pray for Lorraine as she navigates a lot of hoops to try and find the fastest and most efficient way to ship some much needed supplies to Haiti via container. Our recent method of using the US Military program called DENTON, has been temporarily halted due to some complications with Haitian Customs, so we are having to explore alternate ways of getting the materials to Cazale.
