We are conducting multiple Bible classes each week through our clinic chaplains and want to ensure the young people graduating from these classes are connected to healthy and vibrant local church families.
14. Pray for the continued formulation of a development committee in the USA of volunteers that are currently focusing on setting up a system to procure and deliver much needed supplies necessary to sustain our programs and services here in Cazale.
15. Pray for the US Military Denton Program to be able to deliver over 20 pallets of supplies to us. The shipment was scheduled for December and February, but was cancelled both times for security reasons because of the situation in Haiti. The delivery has been rescheduled for March 13.

16. Pray for Katrina Reimer, a longtime friend and volunteer at Real Hope for Haiti who is in her final stages of preparation to move to Haiti and join our staff. 17. Pray for our teacher Anna, as she remains in the USA during a difficult season in her family's life. She continues to support our missionary kids here, so we are thankful technology allows for that, but look forward to the day she is able to return to Haiti to serve alongside us.
18. Pray we are able to invest the time and energy necessary to maintain a healthy and thriving relationship with God, in our marriages, and with our children in our families. Pray God gives us grace to balance all He has entrusted to us.
19. Pray for Casey as he joins the preaching team at an English-speaking church in Port au Prince while they look for a pastor to replace one who recently returned to the USA.
20. Pray for us to remain hopeful for the future, as the realities of life and ministry here in Haiti are at times, heavy and seemingly relentless.
