Specific prayer requests from patients coming through our clinic:

1. Pray for Y.V., a precious little girl admitted into the RC with severe malnutrition. Pray for treatment, medicines, and tender care to be used of God to restore her life and bring her healing.
2. Pray for W.D., a young woman who recently became a Christian through the power of Christ. She responded to evangelism done in the clinic and we are thrilled to call her our sister in faith now. Pray for her to remain rooted in Christ and find a healthy local church in which to grow. Hallelujah!
3. Please pray for several other patients who indicated a desire to profess faith in Christ but were reluctant for various reasons. Please pray for them to clearly understand the person and work of Jesus Christ and what it means for their life and their life to come!
4. Please pray for N.E. that her ear would heal well.
5. Pray for C.M. to be healed and recover from chest pain.
6. Pray for C.T. as she requested prayer for God to bless all areas of her life and allow her to live in peace with her husband.
7. Pray for W.S. asks for prayer for her husband, that he would know the love of Christ and give his life to following Jesus.
8. Pray for S.L.F. who is asking God to change the circumstances of her life because she is very discouraged. She is praying God would provide for her needs and asks us to join her in this prayer.

Prayer requests for our work:

12. Please pray for peace and stability to return to the streets of Haiti. Gangs have caused significant problems in Port au Prince, for months with kidnappings, and recently with increased violence. While this destabilizing activity has been contained to specific parts of Port au Prince, it recently spread. It also creates significant issues near the area that imports gasoline and diesel. Inability to deliver fuel has led to a fuel shortages throughout Haiti. Please pray for some resolution to the current unrest. People are tired and discouraged.
13. Our prayers proved fruitful with the last container of building supplies that cleared customs late in May. So, we invite you to go to the Lord once again and ask Him to make a way to get another container of materials here to Haiti. We are sharing a container with another missionary and there seems to be a shortage of drivers to haul the container from Tulsa, OK to Miami, where it is to be shipped to Haiti. Pray that God would make a way where there seems to be no way so that progress on building projects can continue without delay.
14. Our Haitian staff is incredibly important to us and a valuable part of the impact RHFH has here in the community. Please pray for several of our staff that are enduring some medical hardships. Pray diagnostic tests would help us coordinate their care and successfully get them on track towards recovery. Also remember our staff members who are pregnant, that God would provide them with a safe pregnancy and healthy baby as He blesses their families.
15. Please pray for the safety and wisdom for the construction crews working to make the projects included in Planting Hope a reality. There is a lot of action happening up there and we are thankful for the progress.
