6. R.R. is young lady needing our prayers as she is suffering from seizures.

7. S.D. is a young woman who is having significant discomfort from acid/ heartburn, and asks for prayer that God's mercy and the medications will allow her pain to subside and allow her to function normally again.

8. We have had a sharp increase in our inpatient malnutrition care in recent weeks. Please pray for the families involved, that we can be used of God to help heal these precious little ones and reunite them with their families.
