Being a diabetic anywhere in the world is difficult. Necta knows this and is so thankful for the care that she receives at the RHFH clinic. Medications, lab testing, disease monitoring are part of the blessing RHFH supporters have been able to provide for her and almost 70 people every month. This year, Necta was able to also receive much needed wound care supplies for an infected foot that is now healed. A small wound turned critical very quickly and she was scared she might lose her foot. As she explains it, "With much prayer, patience, dressing changes, medications, advise, and education that I received at the clinic, my foot is healed. It was swollen and hurt very bad. I wasn't discouraged because I knew the clinic staff would support me during my illness. Thank you for helping them to make this possible for me!"

Swollen with kwashiorkor, Rose Mica was brought to the medical clinic where she was admitted for inpatient care in our rescue nutrition center. After treatment, she returned home with her family, who were educated on better nutritional food choices to give her. She also receives a food box from the medical clinic each month to help supplement her diet with vitamins and nutrients. Her family are farmers and often do not have enough money to feed their children. This food plays a critical role in helping Rose Mica maintain her good weight and health. Her parents thank you for the help you have given the clinic so we can continue caring for children like Rose Mica. They hope and pray God blesses you more and more each day.





Tamare, a beautiful 21 year old woman, has had seizures and developmental issues since she was 6 years old. Though her mom searched many places for help, it was very difficult finding a clinic to care for her daughter. When Tamare was 8 years old, she had a very bad seizure that caused her to stop talking. After many years of suffering, a friend told her mom about the RHFH clinic. When Tamare came to the medical clinic for her first visit, we sent her for testing and placed her on medications. As time went by, her mom saw that Tamare was having less seizures and getting healthier. She starting talking in 2018 and everyone was so happy. Tamare's seizures are mostly under control because she has access to the medications and medical care, which you make possible with your generous support. Her mother says that Tamare doesn't have enough words to tell you thank you for all that you have done for her and many other Haitians.

"Stervens has been sick in his belly button since he was 3 months old (now 5 yrs old). I've passed in 10 hospitals with him and we've never found a solution. I had people that gave me advice to turn to vodou, but they ask too much money and I couldn't pay it. I decided to come to the clinic here in Cazale and, with the grace of God, he got better. They gave him appointments to come every three days for wound care and within a month's time it was healed. We give God praise and worship for this miracle that He's done in our lives. If I had gold and diamonds I would give it to the clinic as a sign of gratitude and appreciation, but I don't have that so I will tell God thank you and ask Him to bless you all every day for the good work you are doing in the country.
