3. Pray for S.S. and T.F. who are young ladies both asking for prayer for strength to remain faithful to God and all that He commands.
4. Pray for R.D. to be healed of hypertension.
5. Pray for S.F. who is discouraged and asks prayer for increased joy despite the pain she is experiencing in life.
6. Pray for S.P.R. to have his foot continue to heal and be restored so he can resume his normal life and responsibilities.
7. Pray for J.L. who desires a change in his spiritual life. Pray the love of God is shed abroad in his heart and he senses the presence and the power of God in Christ Jesus.
8. Pray for B.L. who is increasingly concerned with the instability and violence in Haiti and wants prayers of protection for her and her family.

11. Gang violence/ kidnappings continue to plague Port au Prince. This destabilization has led to supply chain interruptions and shortages specifically of fuel. Please pray for resolution and safety and security to return to Port au Prince.
12. Pray for the safety of our missionaries and staff that must travel in and out of Port au Prince for supplies and meetings.
13. Pray for those continuing to recover from the earthquake in the South Peninsula of Haiti. Many large relief organizations are beginning to close their operations, which were helpful. Pray for the mission organizations established in the area to be used of God to help people there put their lives and communities back together.
14. Pray for the leadership of Haiti. Little progress on the president's assassination investigation, no clear plan, continued delays to new elections. Please pray for a clear pathway forward towards a brighter future. Citizens are discouraged.
15. Please pray for our Chaplain Mathurin, who began a four year Bible school in September. Pray for him to connect with other strong students and professors, to grow in his knowledge and passion for God's Word, and that he would be equipped with every good gift he needs to do all God has for him to do.
16. Please pray for our foster children who continue to be cared for by loving families here in Cazale. Many of them began the school year recently. Pray they work diligently and continue to develop into hard working. Christ honoring young men and women.
17. Pray for progress to continue on Planting Hope. We are thrilled to report the two staff houses are completed. We are working on building water cisterns to deliver water to all the new facilities developed on the new land. We are grateful for your partnership and God's provision with so many people lending a helping hand to make this dream He put into our hearts a reality.
