- Pray for A.A. and J.L. who both desire wisdom and strength to do the will of God in their life.
- Pray for P.P.B. as she repents and desires to turn back to God and walk with Christ.
- Pray for T.S. who has chronic abdominal pain and continues to lose weight.
- Pray for D.E. and E.L. who are both diabetics in our care. Pray they are able to work with us to control their blood sugars well and especially for D.E. to gain weight and overcome chronic anemia.

## **Prayers for our Work:**

- The people of Haiti continue to suffer due to insecurity. Please pray for the police to be able to restore order to unstable areas of Port au Prince. Gang activity has ramped up on the side of north side of Port au Prince, which is the area we must travel to access supplies/ airport. Prices of commodities continue to rise, fuel has once again become scarce, as most fuel stations are closed. We are approaching another crisis point, and the population is tired. Pray for a safe, peaceful pathway forward.
- Pray for 3 containers of medical supplies we currently have in Haitian customs. All three arrived recently, but due to current security issues, we are unsure of how functional the ports are at this time. Pray for our customs broker to be able to negotiate the release of these containers/ supplies, and for safe and secure transport to Cazale.
- Pray for our Homes of Hope. Many generously gave and we were able to purchase new beds for each of our foster kids. We are thankful for sponsors that makes this program possible. We are thankful for each Haitian home in our community that chose to partner with us to care for these precious little ones.
- Pray for our annual board meeting that will be in May. Should be an exciting time of dreaming/ planning/ vision casting for the future.
- Pray for us as we have had some unexpected complications/ delays in a couple of the Planting Hope projects. We are currently investigating our options and would appreciate wisdom along the way.
- Pray we continue to be able to find the necessary supplies we need to maintain our programs: medicines, mamba, food, and fuel.

## **Prayers for our Missionary Staff:**

- Pray for the Betors and Lori as they travel to the USA to attend Trey Betor's high school graduation in late May/ early June.
- Pray for our beloved teacher, Miss Anna, as she finishes another successful year here in Haiti and then travels to join the rest to celebrate Trey's graduation.
