- Pray for our garage/ depot project that is ramping up after some delays because of Haiti's security issues making travel increasingly difficult.
- Pray for the police in Haiti to have success in pushing gangs back and helping to restore order and peace to the streets of Port au Prince. Three high profile doctors were kidnapped this month and two hospitals (one a children's hospital) that we frequently refer patients to have temporarily closed until those doctors are released, making an already tenuous situation here in Haiti increasingly perilous to navigate.
- Pray for our patients and staff as they travel in Haiti. Pray for protection and that violence would end.
- Pray for elections to take place and new leadership to lead Haiti forward into a brighter future.
- Pray for us that we are able to continue to secure the supplies we need in regards to medicines, food, medika mamba, fuel/ God has been gracious thus far and we are working hard to maintain ample supply.
- Pray for those in our community who will be planting in anticipation for rainy season to start soon. Pray God would bless their crops, they would yield great harvests, and provide for our community.
