

Today, it is by the grace of God I can give this testimony for my family. I have many problems in my life to be able to take care of my son. It has been difficult for me since he was born. Right now, I am buying used clothing in bulk and reselling it to make money to care for my children. My son was very sick and had lost a lot of weight. The clinic helped him to gain weight and now he is healthy. It is only God that can repay you for the gift you have given me of the life of my son.

M. has been in our inpatient care program in the past. He had been doing well for several years. He became ill and had fever and diarrhea for several weeks. This one bout of illness was enough to make him weak and fall into malnutrition. He was also very anemic. He lost a good amount of weight and began to have signs of kwashiorkor (swelling) in his feet and legs. His family brought him right away. With medika mamba and medications, he was able to make a full recovery and gain 6 pounds.







J.J. is healthy and strong with the hard work of his mom and the helpful care of the nurse. His mother was scared for his well-being when he began having high fevers. After his clinic visit, she gave medications and mamba to heal his body and gain two pounds. He is doing much better today and everyone is so happy for his recovery. This fantastic teamwork saves lives.

R. F. lives with her dad, mom, 5 sisters, and 2 brothers in a 2-room house made of rocks and clay and covered with a tin roof. They are farmers who plant beans, corn, grains, and other crops. They also care for goats and chickens for food and income. She came in with a severe fungal infection all over her head and was given medications that cleared it up in three weeks. We are thankful to those that give medications and to those that donate funds so that we can purchase needed medications here in Haiti. Generous donors made a difference in the health and life of R.F., who is now healed and doing well. She says, "I tell everyone THANK YOU because I came to the clinic and I found the medicines I needed to heal my head. It was white and itchy. I had to cut my hair off and cover my head with a scarf. It is all better now and I'm happy. When my family and I go to church, I'm going to pray for everyone who helps the clinic and those who work there too. Thank you so much!"





L.J is a 49-year-old man who lives about a 30 minute walk from the clinic. He lives in a 3-room house with his wife and their 3 children. He is a farmer and also makes cooking charcoal to sell. Recently, he had a fever and wasn't sleeping well. He lost his appetite and had body pain as well. He received medications that stopped the fever and his sleep and appetite returned to normal. He was coming for a follow-up visit when the chaplain spoke with him and decided to give his life to the Lord. He said that he felt God's grace and is blessed that God would forgive him.
