Diabetics with uncontrolled high blood sugar levels have a high risk of limb infection and amputation. When Dieulina and her family understood her severe infection might cause her to lose her foot, they brought her to the clinic. Hypertension was also diagnosed and treated. She had to move in with family near the clinic from her home about 2 hours away in order to get needed and consistent care. With much time, patience, education, and encouragement from our staff, her blood pressure and blood sugar levels dropped and her foot healed. Dieulina sends her thanks to everyone that has accepted to provide the RHFH clinic with the supplies and funds needed to heal her wound and get her walking once again. Her fear of possibly losing her foot has turned to joy for her improved health and brighter future.

W. lives in a 3-room home with 7 family members. The family are farmers growing beans, corn, and watermelons in their gardens. W. was brought to the clinic because he was small and had a fever. He was sent to the lab to get testing and his family was given education about nutrition, clean water, hygiene, making a household budget, and what food are good for his age group. He gained 4 pounds during his treatment which took 140 days.

This is what his mom had to say: "Thank you to everyone that is a part of the clinic that gave me education and assistance. Thank you to those that give so we can have the medika mamba for the children. It is important to many children. Thank you for helping W. be normal again and not malnourished. Thank you and God bless you."





From mom:

"Life is not easy. Our family sells rice, spinach, beans, and charcoal in the local market and wherever we can to provide for our needs. Sometimes we cannot eat every day. I know that good nutrition is important, but it is hard to find all the foods that she needs to grow. When my daughter began to have swelling, I went to the clinic in Cazale for help. She was admitted for inpatient care the very same day. After 3 months of treatment, she came home with me and is very healthy. I was very happy that she was healed and I thank God for giving her life. Now, if I hear there is a child in my area that is sick, I will tell them go to Cazale because they have good medicine and good advice for people. Thank you!"

Phalandia is not my child, but I love her like she mine. To make it simple to understand, I did not want her to die and no one else would take care of her so I said I would. It has not been easy. She was 4 months old when she came to live at my house. Her feet and legs were swollen and they were painful. The rest of her body was very small. She cried a lot. I came to the clinic to see what I needed to do to care for her. The nurse took a long time talking to me and explaining what I needed to do to care for her. In a few weeks, her swelling went down just like the nurse said it would. I do not have a lot of money. I stay home and care for other kids in the family. I make and sell mats I make out of banana tree leaves that people use to sleep. I came to the clinic every single month for 13 months and received infant formula for Phalandia. I could not have purchased the formula on my own. I am happy to say she is healthy and happy. She makes me happy. I want to thank you for this special program that is at the clinic. I can say with confidence that it is saving the lives of many children.



G. was brought to the clinic by his aunt. His caregiver is his grandmother, but she was too sick to travel to the clinic. He has lived with her since he was born. His birth mother was with him the first few months of his life, but then left and moved to another country to find work. The grandma and G. were both in such bad shape that the family went and brought them down from the mountains to where they are living to find care for both of them. G. was very near death when he was admitted. It took 7 months for him to reach his goal weight. During that time, his grandma also was able to heal and get stronger and feel better. Grandma was able to be present with us the day he was ready to go home.

From grandma: "I wanted to say thank you for what you have done for my grandson - for the help and care that you have given him. What you did I could not do and I thank you for being able to do it. Thank you God, thank you to this clinic. May God give back to you what you have given to my family - Life. Thank you! Thank you so much!"
