- Pray prayers of Thanksgiving that our US Board added another member, Debbie Woodward, during our annual board meeting in May. Debbie has been a longtime supporter and we are excited about the energy she brings. Pray for her and our board as they work to create a strategic plan for moving our ministry and programs forward.
- Pray for some precious kids, that God would provide foster families for them. We have a few Rescue Center kids that need placed in our Homes of Hope program once they finish recovering. We also have a young child sent to us by an orphanage that has recovered, but the orphanage is unable to receive her back at present. In addition, we had an 8-year-old boy with cerebral palsy abandoned in our clinic yard in June. It is likely that each of these children will need to be placed in our Homes of Hope program. Pray for us to find families willing and able to receive them. Pray we find sponsors that would be able to cover the cost of the stipend for them as well. God has answered these prayers for us before for each child in our Homes of Hope program, so we have confidence He will hear our prayers now!
- Pray for opportunities with another organization we connected with in Haiti for possible trauma informed training for parents/ staff that would better equip us all to meet the needs of those God has entrusted to our care.
- Pray for the safety of our patients and staff, as sporadic violence/ kidnapping remains a real threat. Pray for peace to be restored in Haiti, and for elections/ clear pathway forward to be established.

- Pray for the Zachary family as they are on furlough in WA state. Pray for them to get their medical appointments in, and to be refreshed by fellowship at their local church. Also pray blessings upon Casey and Briana as they celebrate 20 years of marriage on July 27.
