The government announced a month delay in starting school to attempt to improve the situation. The population is growing increasingly frustrated.
- Pray for two young children recently abandoned at clinic. Pray we can locate their parents, or, if we are unable to do that, pray we can find a healthy, loving family in Cazale that can care for them in our Homes of Hope program.
- Please pray for the safety of our patients and staff as they travel to and from clinic. Especially pray for those staff members who are obligated to travel into Port au Prince to purchase and pick up supplies.
- Pray prayers of thanksgiving that our friends and Meds & Foods for Kids were able to grant us 25 boxes of medika mamba, in addition to what we purchased. As the number of children suffering malnutrition increases during this difficult season, we are grateful to have an abundant supply of medika mamba, which is key in their recovery and helps lead to better outcomes for these precious little ones who bear the image of God.
- Pray for the gardens of the patient population and communities we serve. The majority of people in our area subsist on producing crops to sell in market. Pray their harvest would be plentiful and that God would provide for their needs.
- Pray donors will respond willingly to our proposal to raise the monthly stipend for our Homes of Hope program families to help cover the increase in cost of living expenses due to inflation. We want to ensure we can give these families and children all they need to continue to thrive as they share life together.
