We are grateful for the hard work of the RHFH staff as well as the Haitian health department (MSPP), the Red Cross, and others to provide education, care, and hygiene prevention items. Please pray with us that our supplies of IV fluids, medications, and cleaning supplies will be restocked this month so that we are ready to assist with future outbreaks.

Also, please be in prayer for safe travels, good rest, and fruitful labors for RHFH teams, volunteers, staff, and interns. June was a busy month of several teams. The current intern who has been working since Jan, Erica, left to go back to US to pursue her education. We are welcoming new interns which we are excited to be introducing you to soon. Casey and his family were on leave in Washington in June. Lori and Charles are still in Washington as Lori gets treatment for a recurrence of uterine cancer. Licia and her family will be in Indiana in July 12 - Aug 16. Zach will be in Indiana around this time too. Jody and Anna are also visiting family back home for the summer.
