His dad became blind and tried his best to care for him, but he began to lose weight and got sick. He was admitted for inpatient care and recovered. We met with his dad and then with his extended family to see what solution they thought would work for Calensky. One of his aunts agreed to care for him. We were excited that he would remain close to his dad and that he could continue to see him. They continue to have a great relationship and the aunt continues to care for him. RHFH helps the family by providing a food box for him and free health care. We look forward to seeing him grow and stay strong with his family.

They gave me an appointment to come back and recheck it once my fever was gone. It was still high so I began taking some medications. I am happy to say that after 1 month I feel so much better. I brought my son to the clinic because he was sick. I had stopped breast feeding him 2 months before he got sick. He did not want to eat or drink much of anything. He lost weight and then his feet began to have edema. I came to the clinic to see if they could help him. He was admitted to the inpatient program where he gained 12 pounds. I want to thank everyone that supported me and my son while he was healing. I cannot believe what my eyes see today and how beautiful my son is. Thank you for helping him, I will take care of him and I pray he will not become sick again.
