Prayer Requests of Patients:

- Pray for Y.F. a man who suffers from a seizure disorder.

- Pray for other missionary friends, many who are currently displaced and forced to return to their home countries because gangs have taken over their mission compounds or areas. Pray for those missionaries who remain, that God would be near them and guide them and that we would find ways to encourage and strengthen one another.
- Pray for our cholera treatment center workers who are going into their 4th month of this difficult task of treating cholera. Pray God strengthens them to persevere in this important and life saving work.
- Pray for our vehicles. We are hauling water to the CTC daily and cannot get to PAP easily to purchase repair parts. Pray God holds them all together!
- One of our primary interventions with malnourished kids is medika mamba, which is produced in country. Due to many factors, they shut down production in last Fall. We purchased as much as we were able at the time, but our supply will run out this month and they have yet to start distribution again. We are using AK-1000, which is helpful, but medika mamba is preferred for the severely malnourished. Pray God would make a way!

Prayer Requests for Our Missionaries:

- Pray for our safety and the safety of our families as we labor for Christ here in Cazale.
- Pray that God would continue to move and challenge and change us in our walks of faith. We are in a hard season, and we need to cling to Christ.
- Pray for our physical bodies and emotional health to have the requisite strength needed for whatever challenge comes. Pray we rest deeply when we get the chance.
- Pray for RHA as they move towards winding down another school year. Pray for Miss Anna as she orders curriculum for our missionary students next Fall. Pray big blessings on Miss Anna!
