Prayer Requests of Patients:

- M needs prayer for corrective surgery for damage from rheumatic heart disease, which is currently unavailable in Haiti.
 - D.P. is an 18-month-old who broke her arm. Pray her mother can find a surgeon to operate on her arm.
 - C is a toddler in our care, who was brought to us by his neighbor, suffering from kwashiorkor. Pray God would restore his health and that his parents would come to visit him.
 - E.F.A. requests pray for change in his spiritual life, that God would touch Him and draw him near.
 - C.J. asks for prayer for pain in her abdomen.
 - T.F. desires prayer for deliverance from spiritual oppression.
 - L.D. requests prayer that she has a safe delivery and healthy baby.
 - C.B. asks prayer for provision and protection for 3 kids she is raising.
 - B.M. wants prayer for his child who is unable to walk.
 - E.D. is a 21-year-old young man with a swollen body needing healing.

Prayer Requests for Our Work:

- Pray for us as we add several additional support staff at clinic this month in addition to a Haitian doctor. Pray we are able to orient them well and they will catch the vision for this important work.
 - Pray for our employees who are working hard to ensure we remain stocked with medicines, fuel, medika mamba, food, and more. This month our staff transported supplies to Cazale via boat to circumvent gang-controlled roads between us and Port au Prince. We've had other staff trek over mountains by foot multiple times to bring back 110 cases of medika mamba with donkeys and mules, about a 6-8 hike one way!
 - Pray for the country of Haiti, that continues in the political/ economic malaise and insecurity due to gang activity and a lack of political leadership. Pray the church would be strong in this season and that God would ease the pain of those suffering.
 - Pray for our vehicles. The rainy season is almost here. Port au Prince is the primary place we purchase auto parts for repair, and they are getting increasingly difficult to find. Pray that our vehicles will hold together and be dependable.
 - Pray for continued cooperation with local authorities and national government agencies as we attempt to get birth certificates and legal documents for the children in our Hope Homes program, several of which were abandoned at clinic.
