Once she began to recover, she enjoyed playing with dolls and legos. Her mom says, "I wanted to thank you for everything. I am happy that my daughter is healed and so beautiful now. I pray that God continues to help you in everything that you do."

Christella came to the clinic with severe wounds and stayed for a few months to receive antibiotic shots and daily dressing changes, as well as being added to the medika mamba program. The program helped with her healing, and her mother expressed gratitude towards the clinic for their help and prayed for its continued success.

Cholera hit our area on October 23, 2022 and you all were very gracious to lend a hand to care for those who were ill, provide aid to families, and promote health education. Today, with the grace of God and your partnership, cholera has decreased enough in our area that the CTC can be closed down until there is another need. Words fall short of expressing our deep gratitude for your generosity and love shown during this time. Cholera hits hard and fast, killing up to 50% of those without medical treatment. You made sure this didn't happen. In the 168 days we were open, 1330 people were treated and made a full recovery. We will always be ready for another spike, but for now cholera has decreased and we are closing the center today, April 9th. Celebrate life and hope with us on this beautiful EASTER day! Jesus is the REAL HOPE for us all no matter how sick, how broken, how far away. He is risen and alive!

I wanted to say thank you to the clinic. Last year I was very sick and could not even walk without help. When I came to the clinic they gave me medications but also a food box each month. This helped me to be able to eat. I also took my medications each day. By the Grace of God I can say today that I am well.
