

During the fourth quarter, we provided care for a total of 64 patients. This included 23 new admissions. 5 unfortunate deaths. and 28 successful discharges. Unfortunately, our main nurse at the rescue center left to go to another country. We have been working diligently to train a new person to fill her position. In addition, we had pillows sewn for each child's bed, and new sheets are being sewn for the upcoming year.

A total of 4892 patients were given care, including 2,263 children under 14 years old. A rabies outbreak, requiring quick intervention and collaboration with health and vet officials, is now in better control. Birthing supplies were provided for 68 babies born this quarter. Wound care nurses changed 1909 dressings, cared for 84 emergencies, and sutured 48 lacerations. Health topics for group education focused on finances, agriculture, HIV, and family values.

Another spike of cholera became active in our area this quarter. We received 645 patients at our 24/7 care center who were treated with 1020 liters of IV fluid and 3858 liters of oral rehydration drink. There were 202 suspected cases and 58 specimens tests at the national lab.
