Impact

Rescue Center

A 50 bed inpatient care center to
treat severe malnutrition

108 children admitted and given special therapeutic foods,
treated for infections, and families educated

Medical Clinic

Accessible and affordable outpatient
health care for the whole family

21,528 patients received care including 380 emergencies, 326
newborns, 6842 wound care, and 13,786 lab tests. 49% of
children under 5 years old were malnourished and 2196 people
were given food.

Cholera Treatment Center

A 36 bed center to treat dehydration
encountered from cholera

Reopening October 2022, 362 patients were treated from 3
counties in a 15 miles radius. 41% were children under 5 yrs.

Foster Care

Loving families integrating at-risk and
abandoned children into long-term
care homes

18 fragile children cared for in devoted family environments with
monthly medical check-ups and quarterly home visits.
