During my pregnancy, I experienced severe weakness and fatigue, prompting me to seek medical attention at a clinic. The nurse prescribed prenatal vitamins to be taken daily, which helped me regain my energy levels. These vitamins also enabled me to work again and support my family. Now, at seven months old, he is at a healthy weight and I am grateful for the difference the vitamins made in my life.

Thanks to the generous contributions from RHFH supporters, Frandy was able to receive treatment and was discharged from the Cholera Treatment Center today. He was severely dehydrated and on the brink of death due to diarrhea and vomiting, but the IV fluids, medications, and RHFH staff supported by donations made all the difference.







After several months of not feeling well, I visited the clinic. I took a pregnancy test, and to my surprise, it was positive. I had no idea that I was pregnant. I began visiting the clinic monthly for check-ups. I received a birthing kit today, which will be helpful during my home birth. I am grateful for the care that the clinic has provided, and I want to say thank you.

I reside in a two-room home constructed of palm tree wood and topped with a tin roof. Four people, including myself, live here, and we make a living through farming. Recently, my child fell ill, prompting me to seek medical attention at the clinic. Although I had heard about God before, I had never made the decision to accept Him into my life. During my visit to the clinic, I spoke with several people and received their guidance. Finally, I decided to make the decision and accept God in my life.



VISION: Physically, relationally, and spiritually healthy people contributing to thriving families and strong communities as God designed and desires.

Midnaelle is one of four siblings who lives at home with her mother, and grandmother. Her health began to deteriorate when she stopped breastfeeding and then was only eating one meal a day. Her mother brought her to the clinic in search of help, as she had severe edema all over her body, including her face. After two weeks on the medika mamba program, Midnaelle lost four pounds of water weight due to kwashiorkor and began eating well, reaching her goal weight in seven weeks. Your contributions have made a significant difference in the lives of children who, like Midnaelle, who need medical attention at the Rescue Center.





Carmene is a 39 year old woman who is a farms with her older children. Her husband moved to Chili to try to make a living. She sells their produce to make a living and keeps some for the family to eat. They live in a 4-room rock and cement house about a 3 hour walk to the clinic. Before her husband left, she became pregnant and the baby was stillborn. Since that time, her blood pressure has been high. She is currently on two medications and comes monthly for check-ups and a med refill.



She says, "Since I've been taking medicine, I feel better. I have many people in my family who have high blood pressure. My mother developed high blood pressure and she died from it. That's what made me come to the hospital - so I don't die like my mother because I want to take care of my children. I say thank you because you gave me the opportunity to find blood pressure medication. Only God can reward that. My blood pressure is better now. Thank you!"

Little Dave came to the clinic sick and malnourished. His dad passed away and the family had a difficult time making ends meet. We were able to work with his mom and work out a plan of care for him and help the family with food boxes.
