A kind passerby found him and took him to a hospital. There he received initial treatment but was told he needed \$7000 Haitian to stitch his arm. With no money, Borderon was in a tough spot until he was brought to the clinic. We welcomed him and treated his injuries for free. We stitched up his arm and provided about two months of care until he was completely healed, all at no cost. Borderon was overwhelmed with gratitude and said, "I don't know how to thank the staff enough for what you've done for me. I was desperate, with my arm nearly severed to the bone and no money for treatment at another hospital. But you took me in and fixed my arm without charging me. I'm at a loss for words to express how thankful I am. May God bless you for the kindness you've shown me. THANK YOU SO MUCH."
