

Claudia, a 17-month-old girl, arrived at a clinic severely malnourished, cared for by her devoted grandmother who traveled for hours to get her the help she needed. The family, who are farmers, work hard to grow corn, beans, and peppers, but still struggle to make ends meet. They live in a simple four-room house with a tin roof, along with seven other family members. Their life is challenging, especially when it comes to accessing healthcare.

Despite her critical condition upon arrival and admission to the rescue center, her treatment of special milk and nutrient-rich foods started to show positive results. Claudia gained 5 pounds, a hopeful sign of recovery, thanks to her grandmother's love and the dedicated care she received.







Since we lost my sister-in-law on January 9, 2024, and my brother became incapacitated from a work accident, I've taken on the role of caregiver for my four nieces and nephews. My brother's injury, caused by a falling bucket of cement and his subsequent inability to work, thrust me into a situation I never expected. My wife, feeling no maternal bond with B.G., the youngest at 6 months, left me to care for her while managing the farm. I devised a way to keep B.G. close in the fields, creating a cradle in a basin for her to rest, ensuring she was tended to alongside my agricultural duties.

The support from RHFH, especially formula, has been so good. It's not just about the nutrition; it symbolizes the kindness and support from others, which has been critical in keeping my family afloat during these tough times. I'm deeply thankful for this generosity as it has significantly impacted B.G.'s well-being. This assistance is a reminder of the good still in the world. Thank you!
