  her to voodoo temple. Pray treatment would work, the parents would listen to counsel, and that this would be
  an opportunity for clear Gospel presentation.

- Pray for B.E. to be granted strength and courage to continue to advance in life and provide for herself.
- Pray for P.S. who asks prayer for God to deliver him from alcohol addiction.
- Pray for E.V. who needs prayer for relief of pain and other physical symptoms.
- Pray for M.A. as they are a recent follower of Christ. Pray God grant her discipline to walk in the ways of the Lord and honor Him with her life.

## Prayer Requests for Our Work:

- Pray for the international community attempting to put together a coalition of troops, led by 1,000 Kenyan
  police officers, to come conduct an operation to combat gang violence and return peace and stability to Haiti.
  There have been many obstacles along the way, and it appears the population of Haiti is waiting for it to
  happen. Pray leaders would lead and consider what is best for those hurting in Haiti.
- Pray for us to secure enough supplies to maintain our services. Reports that Haitian customs haven't released shipping containers in almost a month due to gang violence near the port. This is resulting in beginning to see a shortage of supplies, as we currently cannot find enough rice locally to support our programs.
- Pray for continued safety and favor as our staff travels through Haiti. We are thankful Licia and Charles made
  it safely to the airport in Cap Haitien to depart in mid Feb. However the day they flew out, and the day after our
  staff returned to Cazale with meds and medika mamba, the road was blocked, and roads through Mirabalais
  have been blocked since then as well. This is our only route to travel and to get supplies, and if this is also cut
  off, we will be seriously isolated in Cazale.
- Pray for us as we add a couple new board members in the first quarter of 2024. We are grateful for all who serve on our board of directors, appreciate their wise counsel and genuine support.
- Pray for two new nurses that will be beginning to work in the Rescue Center full time. Working with acutely malnourished children is challenging and complicated, so pray these nurses will build quality relationships with other staff and parents, and be used by God to help contribute to better outcomes and stronger families.
- Pray for us and our board as we continue to investigate projects to build a new clinic and rescue center. There are many variables involved, and the timing is hard to gauge, as this project would not be possible until Haiti stabilizes. We want to trust God through the process. Pray God fills us with faith.
