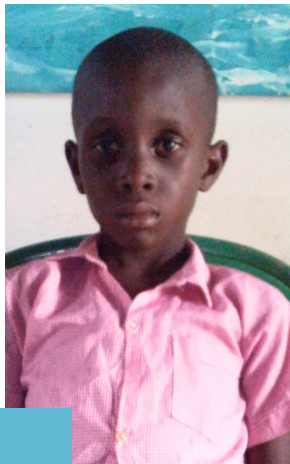

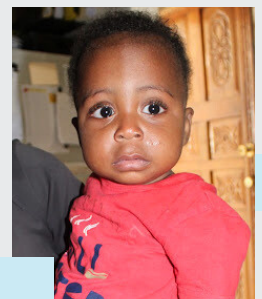

Sonder's life began with tragedy. His mother, ill since her pregnancy, unfortunately lost the battle and died only 16 days after his birth. Her father, who had already abandoned his mother, was absent from his life. But luckily, Sonder's grandparents took over and raised him lovingly. His grandfather always accompanied Sonder to the clinic, where the staff was dedicated to helping them. They decided to help him by providing him with formula to nourish him. Despite the lack of breast milk, he remained healthy and thrived under the loving care of his grandparents and the clinic staff. Sonder became a lively, curious, and full of life child. The generosity of people who decided to donate money to buy formula for babies like Sonder is amazing. Their support has made a real difference in his life and others with similar journeys, giving them a chance to grow up healthy.



Ketteline, a mother of two, has chosen to breastfeed because of its health benefits and cost-effectiveness; it eliminates the need to buy formula. However, breastfeeding can be physically demanding, and Ketteline sometimes experiences weakness, particularly at night. When this happens, she eats something to regain her strength for continued nursing.

She finds breastfeeding immensely beneficial; her children rarely fall sick, even during teething, and they're developing quickly. By four months, they are starting to sit up and are generally happy.

Seeing these positive outcomes, Ketteline encourages expectant mothers to consider breastfeeding for its role in promoting rapid and healthy child development.

Elina relied on the clinic throughout her pregnancy and gave birth to her second daughter, Elnayda. We provided Elina with a birthing kit, which delighted her. She expressed her gratitude by saying, "Thank you for giving me what I lacked, which will help me take better care of my daughter and keep her clean."
