Snaylie, a 21-month-old girl, lives with her family. When her mother brought her to the clinic for flu and diarrhea, we diagnosed severe malnutrition; she weighed only 7.8kg instead of 9.5kg. We enrolled her in the Medika Mamba program, providing 25 packages every two weeks. After two months, Snaylie's health and weight improved significantly. Her grateful mother thanked the clinic staff for their dedicated care and encouraged them to continue helping other children.
