Thanks to donations from Matter, we had the bandages and supplies to help her. Your support truly impacts lives here in Haiti.



By our next appointment, our skin had healed, and Djoudnaelle's weight had increased to 10 pounds. By the second visit, she weighed 12 pounds and was no longer malnourished.
