
PRAYERS UP! DECEMBER 2024

This Haitian doctor has been displaced due to the current crisis and found himself in Cazale, and we are grateful to have him on our team during this season.
- Pray for our community development group, GVADK, which is ramping up activities and refocusing on serving and strengthening the local community.
- Pray for our staff. Many of them take their vacations during the end of December. (They get 2 weeks off per year.) This has been an extremely taxing year for them with the current state of Haiti. Pray their time off would be refreshing and restore their strength and grant them some much needed and much deserved rest. We are thankful to have dedicated staff with such grit and determination.

• Pray for contingency plans being put together in case an escalation of violence or threat of violence forces us to evacuate the children in the Rescue Center.



As the current crisis stretches into its third year, many missionaries have been
displaced and forced to live outside of Haiti for long periods of time. Many of our
missionary friends are discouraged, their efforts to hold their ministries together from a
distance are showing signs of strain and fragmentation. When Haiti stabilizes, we need
