I am the oldest of six siblings, raised by my mother after my father abandoned us. Pregnant and with a three-year-old, she struggled to provide for us in a two-room home. To manage, she sent the older children to high school and the younger ones to national schools. She even started gardening to support us. Despite hardships, my mother never lost hope. She prayed for me to attend university and sacrificed greatly, even selling a pig, to pay my entrance fees. Through God's grace, I graduated and found a job at RHFH immediately. This opportunity transformed my family's life. I funded my sisters' education, sent my brother abroad, and improved my mother's living conditions. I thank God and RHFH for these blessings. Your dedication has changed our lives. I pray for wisdom, strength, and God's guidance for the mission and its staff.

Sandrine, 39, lives with her husband and six children. One day, a metal container of coffee exploded, spilling hot liquid on her face and arm, causing severe burns. In pain, she came to the clinic, where nurses bandaged her wounds. She returned daily, and with the treatments and medication, her pain eased, and her burns healed. Now fully recovered, Sandrine is grateful for the care she received and thanks the donors, whose support made her healing possible.

I work at the nutrition center preparing food for malnourished children. Thanks to your generosity, we provide 3 nutritious meals daily to over 20 kids, helping them regain strength and recover. We see remarkable progress daily as their appetite improves, their weight increases, and their health is restored. Your support truly transforms lives, giving these children hope. Davens was admitted to the nutrition center on Oct 2023 at 10 months old, in a critical condition. He suffered from severe malnutrition, showing symptoms of marasmus and kwashiorkor, anemia with only 8.6 grams of blood, weighing only 10 pounds, and having no appetite. His condition upon arrival was so concerning that no one thought he would survive. Davens was fed with F-75 milk from his arrival until October 23, when we were able to switch to F-100 milk. However, after 5 days on the latter, he experienced deterioration, and we had to revert to F-75 milk. A turning point in Davens' health was the introduction of tuberculosis treatment, which started on October 31. Additionally, he benefited from a dedicated team that cares for him, feeds him, plays with him, and administers his medications. Thanks to the collective effort of this team, Davens regained his appetite and started gaining weight. With each passing day, Davens showed significant progress. He now weighs 21 pounds, without any edema, and is no longer in a state of marasmus or kwashiorkor. We have seen a revitalized Davens emerge, staying healthy with his mom at home.





Luxon, 56, lives with his wife and four of their eight children. For fifteen years, he suffered from hydrocele. Although he underwent surgery in 2015, the symptoms returned, and the country's instability made a second operation difficult as so many hospitals were closing. Thanks to generous donations, Luxon finally found hope and relief. After several tests, he underwent successful surgery with his wife and daughter by his side, all expenses covered through your kindness. Now fully healed, Luxon continues follow-up care to ensure his recovery. He deeply thankful for your support, which has restored his health and allowed him to enjoy a normal, peaceful life once again.

When 7-year-old John Wesley arrived at the clinic, he weighed just 36 pounds and suffered from severe malnutrition, 2+ edema, and a fever. He was stabilized with F-75 therapeutic milk and transitioned to medika mamba for nutritional recovery. After losing water weight from the edema, his weight dropped to 32 pounds. However, with consistent care and proper nutrition, he reached his goal weight of 42 pounds in just five weeks.
