I am part of the RHFH team and want to share a story about Mantha, an 11-month-old baby. He came to our clinic in a very weak condition, suffering from severe malnutrition and rashes. After a nurse examined him, he was sent to the lab for tests, which showed his hemoglobin level was dangerously low at 4.3 g/dL. The nurse prescribed treatment and scheduled a follow-up appointment. Later that month, he returned, and his hemoglobin level had improved to 8.3 g/dL. This progress was possible thanks to the teamwork of the lab and nursing staff. We're thankful for those who support our lab with equipment and resources. Your generosity changes lives. Thank you!

Géraldine, 16, is a young girl with disabilities who cannot speak or walk. After losing her mother, she came to the clinic for care. Life at the nutrition center was challenging due to her specific needs, but being placed with a foster family changed everything. Wilno, an 8-year-old boy, was referred to our clinic suffering from severe malnutrition. He weighed just 30 pounds which was 3 levels below normal for weight-toheight ratio. His mother, a farmer earning \$62 monthly, traveled 10 hours to reach us. Living in a small home without running water, Wilno had been losing weight for months and had no appetite. His mother had tried several things to help him, but nothing was working. When she came, the nurses spent time listening to her, educating her on nutritious foods, and encouraging her as a mother. He was admitted and began treatment with F-75 milk formula, later transitioning to Medika Mamba, alongside other needed medications. After a month in our nutrition center, Wilno's weight increased to 37 pounds, and his health was restored. His grateful mother thanks our donors for giving Wilno a second chance at life.





Davidson, 15, had never attended school until age 13. Thanks to your generous donations, he began his education, excelling in his first year with an 8.9 average. Now in his second year of primary school, Davidson dreams of becoming a civil engineer and has hope for a brighter future. He wishes every child could attend school for free, just as he has, believing education opens doors to endless possibilities. Aisha arrived at the nutrition center at 5 months old, weighing 7 pounds but suffering from severe malnutrition with 3+ edema. The medical team provided medicine, vitamins, and special milk, and her swelling reduced to 6 pounds. After two months, Aisha's health improved, and she left the center happy and playful at 10 pounds. Her aunt now brings her for monthly follow-ups to receive infant formula.
