RESCUE CENTER

The Rescue Center provided round-the-clock care for 143 severely malnourished children in its 45-bed facility, using 408 cans of therapeutic milk to support their recovery. The center also created jobs for 41 dedicated staff members.

CLINIC

The clinic provided 21,866 consultations, including 258 newborns, 8,395 pediatric, and 1,825 prenatal visits. Our staff of 29 treated 776 cases of anemia, 2302 skin infections, 773 emergencies, 1264 cases of diarrhea. We performed 10,306 dressing changes and 14,034 lab tests.

HOPE HOMES

The Hope Homes program currently supports 24 children. Over the past year, 2 staff conducted a total of 96 home visits. Sixteen children are enrolled in school full-time, with four receiving additional tutoring throughout the year.

Our food programs supported 31 infants with formula, 163 families with dry food, and 1,208 children with malnutrition treatment, providing essential nutrition and hope despite ongoing challenges.



A total of 26 children were enrolled in the K-12 school program, while 7 individuals had the opportunity to attend university to become medical professionals.
