Holens lives with his parents and 9 relatives in a home without running water. His father is a motorcycle taxi driver, and his mother was too sick to breastfeed. As a result, Holens lost weight for months and developed swelling in his legs. His mother traveled 45 minutes by motorcycle to bring him to the clinic, where he was diagnosed with severe malnutrition. He received F-100 milk, then medika mamba once he reached 6 months old. His weight increased from 6 to 10.8 pounds. Thanks to donors, he continues receiving care and growing stronger.

Gicardine, 30, lives with her daughter and is expecting another baby. She comes to the clinic every month for check-ups to stay healthy during her pregnancy. One day, she told us she wanted a Bible to learn more about God. We were happy to give her one, and she was very thankful. She said it was something she really needed. Our chaplains prayed with her and gave her encouragement.








Marvens, 10 months old, suffered from diarrhea, vomiting, and loss of appetite, dropping to 16 lbs 5 oz. The nurse provided zinc, oral rehydration solution, and enrolled him in the Medika Mamba program. His parents received 28 sachets, with instructions to give him one per day. After two months, Marvens' weight increased to 18 lbs 5 oz, and he regained his health. His mother shared, "Before Medika Mamba, he couldn't eat or play. Now he plays, eats, and is healthy again." Thank you, donors, for giving children like Marvens a second chance at life!

Falandia, a 3-year-old girl, had a difficult start in life. Just 15 days after birth, her mother, who struggles with mental health issues, abandoned her. A kind woman took her in and has cared for her like her own child. Since then, we have helped by providing baby formula, medicine, and food through the AK-1000 flour program to help her gain weight. Her care giver is very grateful, saying she couldn't have done it alone. Today, Falandia is healthy and growing well.

Thank you, dear donors, for transforming lives! Makenley, a 25-month-old boy, was referred to us. After a long journey, his parents arrived at our clinic where we noted he weighed 19.8 pounds, had swelling with 2+ edema, fever, flu, wheezing, and was suffering from mild malnutrition (-1). Following lab tests, we admitted him to the nutrition center and created a treatment plan. He received ceftriaxone for 7 days, azithromycin for 5 days, along with vitamins and other essential medications.



While administering treatment, we ensured he ate nutritious foods to aid recovery. We cared for him as our own—bathing, playing with, and closely monitoring him. Gradually, Makenley's health improved: the swelling subsided, his weight stabilized, and he was no longer malnourished. After 3 months of care, Makenley's weight increased and he was healthy. His father expressed heartfelt thanks, grateful for leaving with a recovered child.



A.D., a 20-month-old girl, lives with her grandparents and father, who brought her to the clinic for diarrhea, fever, and skin rashes. After evaluation, we provided ORS, Zofran, and azithromycin syrup. Her weight, 17 pounds, was below average, so she was enrolled in the Medika Mamba program. Over three months, she received daily Medika Mamba, and her condition improved. Her weight increased to 19 pounds, and she recovered fully. Her grateful father thanked our team and donors for changing his daughter's life. Your generosity makes this possible!

Marie-France, a 38-year-old woman, came to the clinic with swelling and spots on her body. After tests, she was prescribed medication. While still healing, Marie-France met with the clinic's chaplains, who prayed with her and encouraged her to trust Jesus Christ. Moved by their words, she placed her faith in God, finding peace in His promise from Matthew 11:28: "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest." Grateful, Marie-France said, "Thank you for your constant support in my illness. Thanks to the chaplaincy service at the clinic, I have found peace in Christ.
