CLINIC

6001 We served patients, including 2,048 children under 14. Birthing supplies, education, and consultations were done for 72 newborns and moms. Nurses did 2,492 dressings changes and managed 197 emergencies. We treated 751 skin infections and 406 fungal infections. Also 248 diarrhea cases were treated and none were suspected cholera. We identified and referred 20 HIV+ cases. Group education focus was focused on trash management, good hygiene to prevent infection, and skin conditions in children.

RESCUE CENTER

This quarter, our inpatient care facility served a total of 39 children, providing them with medical care, nutrition, and support. We welcomed 12 new admissions, and we are grateful that 14 children recovered and were able to return home to their families. To meet the nutritional needs of the children in our care, we prepared and served 7,922 meals, using 568 pieces of chicken and 952 cups of beans. Keeping up with daily care also required 53 pounds of laundry soap to maintain cleanliness and hygiene.

OUTREACH

We enrolled 334 people in the mamba program, with graduating, 4,704 meals reached 98 Food Box families monthly. Hope Homes sheltered vulnerable children individuals received medical home support. Our education aid includes 21 school sponsorships and 4 university trainees (1 doctor, 2 nurses, 1 PT) committed to joining RHFH. We distributed 263 pieces of Biblical literature, gave 627 spiritual counsel, and special prayer for 591 people. Surgery and emergency aid was given to 10 people referred to 3 hospitals.

Thanks to your generosity, Andrenet, an 11-year-old boy who suffered a tragic accident and life-altering injuries, successfully underwent his first crucial surgery. After enduring tremendous hardship and lacking funds for necessary operations, your donations have given him renewed hope. Now, he looks forward to healing, returning to school, and living free from pain. THANK YOU!
