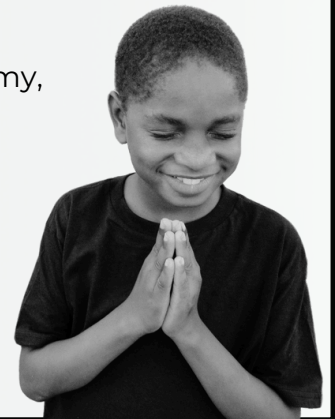


# PRAYERS UP!

## Our Work

- Pray for our staff to continue to find ways to secure supplies and transport them back to Cazale safely. The city of Mirebalais being under gang control is currently preventing them from taking the route they have travelled the last 1.5 years to north Haiti.
- Pray for two of our chaplains, Mathurin and Espeson, who are both graduating from different Bible schools this summer. Pray God continues to equip them with every good gift they need to do all He has called them to do.
- Pray for peace and security to return to Haiti. Pray for elections scheduled for November 2025 to take place so new leadership can be established to lead Haiti forward. A recent UN report indicated serious doubts these important elections will happen this year due to security issues. Haiti has not had a functional government in place of elected officials since the expiration of the previous terms in 2020.
- Pray for our missionary friends, the Lloyd family, who have the 1 year anniversary of the deaths of their son and daughter in law, Davy and Natalie, who were killed by the gangs in May of 2024. Pray God's continued comfort and mercy through this season of loss.
- Pray for our medical professionals working at Real Hope for Haiti, to maintain focus and provide the best possible care to patients in very challenging times.
- Pray for our staff that put themselves at risk, leaving Cazale to secure supplies.

- Pray for our supply of medika mamba to be sustained, as production and distribution in Haiti has been on pause. We have not been able to pick up medika mamba since January. Due to the instability of Haiti, we tried to stay months ahead with our inventory of mamba, but that supply is now running rather low. Medika Mamba is a primary intervention in malnutrition treatment and a critical component of this important work. Pray God makes a way for production and distribution to resume quickly.



- Pray for two of our chaplains that are finishing Bible School this Spring and will be graduating. Pray God would bless them as they have invested time and energy into study, and that it will result with much fruit for the Kingdom of God and the benefit of Real Hope for Haiti's patients and community.

- Pray for Charly and Lori as they remain in Cazale, laboring for Christ in challenging circumstances.
- Pray for Briana as she recently had an abnormal chest x-ray and follow up CT scan. After having Tuberculosis in 2016-2017, she has annual chest x-rays. While she does not feel bad, something is going on in her right lung. Please pray the labs and follow up tests will provide a clear picture of the problem and treatment plan for successful resolution.
- Pray for Casey and Licia as there is currently no safe passage to Cazale, so their planned trips to Cazale have been postponed.
- Pray for our missionary kids Ameyah, Grace, Isaiah, and Gretchen as they finish up their school year in May. They are all growing fast (teenagers!). Pray God continues to capture their hearts and bless them as they grow and mature towards becoming adults and launching into their own lives and careers.
