




REAL HOPE FOR HAITI

H., 84 yrs old, has long been treated at the clinic for high blood pressure. As his condition worsened with age, he could no longer work, making daily life more difficult. To help, the clinic began giving him a box of food each month during his medical visits. For the past 10 years, H. has received both medication and food support. His niece shared: "The medicine helps, but sometimes there's no food. This box feeds him for days. Thank you for your care."

Charlens, in foster care, shared how happy he is to have a bed in his new home. Before, he had to sleep on the floor, which was cold and uncomfortable. He often couldn't rest well and felt tired. Now, with his own bed, he sleeps comfortably at night and can rest during the day when needed. He's grateful for the comfort and warmth it brings. Yvena, an 18-month-old ray of sunshine, arrived at our clinic frail and unwell. Her mother struggled to care for her when she stopped eating. A great aunt brought her to us weighing just 8 pounds 3 ounces and suffering from severe malnutrition. After running lab tests, we designed a tailored treatment plan: therapeutic milk, Medika Mamba, and nourishing foods chosen for her needs. Her cheerful spirit—laughing and playing—lifted our hearts as she spent seven months at the nutrition center. Day by day, her strength grew, and her weight climbed. When she left, Yvena tipped the scales at 24 pounds 14 ounces, healthy and full of energy. Moments like these—seeing a child blossom from fragile to flourishing—are the greatest joys of our mission. Thank you from the bottom of my heart for the bed you gave to my foster son, Lorvens. A bed plays an essential role in a child's life—it protects them from the dampness of the ground and offers a space of comfort and security. As a parent, I've always dreamed of giving him his own bed, a place where he could feel safe, valued, and equal to his brothers and sisters. Life hasn't been easy for him, and to this day, I don't even know if he ever had the chance to sleep in a real bed. Seven days after Mania was born, her mother passed away. Without access to breast milk or formula, her father and grandmother struggled to keep her healthy. She quickly became malnourished. Two months later, they brought her to our clinic. We assessed her condition, enrolled her in our malnutrition program, and began providing a special nutritional formula with regular follow-ups.
