Our Work

- Pray for the maker and distributor of medika mamba, our primary intervention for malnutrition. They have not distributed the product since January, and our supply is running low. Please pray issues delaying production would resolve and they can continue to make this life saving product.
- Pray for the power and wonder of the Gospel to wash over those who come through our gates. Two people received salvation and were made new creations early in May at clinic. Pray for them to connect with a healthy local church, develop and be disciplined into Christ exalting followers of the one who called them out of darkness into His marvelous light!
- Pray for boldness in proclaiming clearly the power of Christ to liberate and the hope He brings. Pray for a harvest of salvations in this incredibly tough season in Haiti, where hope for a brighter future seems to be fading. Pray Jesus would show up big and lost people would turn towards Him and His goodness and His grace.

- Pray for the Light of Christ to reach the dark strongholds of gang controlled territories and the hearts of those perpetrating evil. Pray our faith and expectation of what God might do will rise, that gang members would turn from evil to the living God.



- Pray for efforts to establish the framework and security situation that would allow democratic elections to take place for the first time since 2016. Due to previous terms ending, the country has not had a functional government since 2020. The current presidential council was appointed and their mandate ends Feb 7, 2026.

- Pray for Briana as she is having a bronchoscopy to try to determine what is going on in her right lung. A chest xray and follow up CT scan were problematic and they are seeking more information to determine steps of treatment. This could be related to tuberculosis she had in 2016-2017.
- Pray for Lori and Charly as they are in the thick of it down in Haiti. Loss of safe road passage to Cazale (via Mirabalais) is currently preventing scheduled trips by Licia and Casey to Cazale to assist them. Pray God would sustain them with strength and lean deeply into Jesus for such a time as this.
- Pray for all our missionaries. The current crisis in Haiti has disrupted so much, the Betor and Zachary families are not currently in Haiti full time, there is no indication the circumstances will improve anytime soon, and frustration and disappointment are settling in. We all need the joy and hope of God to lead our staff well, so please pray God would draw us near to Him, we would sense His nearness, and we would walk in His peace that passes all understanding.
