Carla, 11, repeatedly fell behind—until she began attending **leçons**. She advanced to 5th grade and it's a meaningful step forward that has boosted her confidence and determination. Thank you to everyone who supports these lessons. Your help gives children like Carla a real chance to succeed.

Thanks to your generosity, children in Families of Hope attend **leçons** that transform their education. Ten-year-old Elmise improved steadily—7.94 → 8.10 → 8.84—and now enters 2nd grade with a wonderful 8.94 average (out of 10.0). Your support gives them confidence, hope, and the tools to succeed.



My name is Christela, I'm 22 and from Lacoupe, six hours from the clinic. As a baby I was admitted with severe malnutrition—my mother was too sick to visit, but my aunt stayed by my side. The clinic nursed me back to health. I returned recently worried about my heart; the staff welcomed me, treated me, and assured me all is well. I'm deeply grateful for the care that saved my life and gives me peace today. Thank you.

Nagelande arrived quiet and unsure, but **leçons** gave her the space to grow. With patient tutors and steady practice, her confidence and skills blossomed—she moved from struggling to steady progress and now faces the next grade with a bright smile. 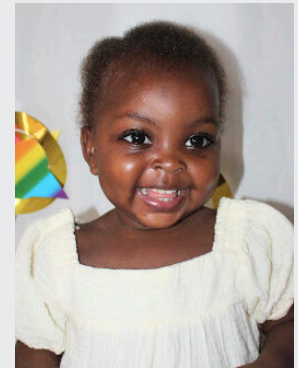


VISION: Physically, relationally, and spiritually healthy people contributing to thriving families and strong communities as God designed and desires.

Miyouca, a 23-month-old girl from Conoye, arrived at our clinic after a nearly six-hour journey with her grandfather and aunts. At admission she was critically ill and weighed just 15 pounds 10 ounces. Because her family depends on farming and had few resources, she needed intensive care.

For eight months our team fed her, gave medical care, and surrounded her with gentle attention and play. With therapeutic milk and Medika Mamba, and the steady dedication of staff, Miyouca slowly regained strength. Today she is completely recovered, free of swelling, and now weighs 24 pounds 4 ounces—a lively, smiling little girl.

Guerline, a 23-year-old mother from Bateau — a six-hour walk from our clinic — arrived eight days after giving birth, struggling to breathe with swollen hands and feet and dangerously high blood pressure. We hospitalized her and, thanks to donors' support, provided the medicines and close care she needed, including Enalapril, potassium, and furosemide. Surrounded by compassionate staff, Guerline recovered and has returned home to care for her newborn. Thank you for helping mothers like her find health and hope.

Chrisha, 71, lives with her son in Cabaret. After a house fire left her with severe burns to her hands and feet, she came to our clinic for care. There she met our chaplains, who prayed with her and shared God's love. Having been away from church for years, Chrisha found deep comfort and renewed peace as she listened to Scripture.
