Claudine arrived at the clinic severely malnourished, weighing just 13.5 pounds. With guidance for her parents and Medika Mamba support, she gained strength and reached 16 pounds in three months. No longer malnourished, her mother expressed deep gratitude. Your support makes this possible.



At first light, the courtyard of RHFH welcomed patients seeking more than physical care—they also needed spiritual and social support. We discussed hope, prayer, and God’s light, then the importance of human connection for courage and security. As a chaplain, I encouraged them to speak and get to know one another. Shy smiles turned into shared jokes and solidarity. One patient said, “Thank you... You not only helped us feel better, but you reminded us that we exist.” Simple conversation can bring warmth and hope.

Mrs. Emmanuel, 57 years old, and a mother of nine, discovered she had hypertension at our clinic in 2004. Since then, she’s received monthly medication, including Enalapril, which keeps her blood pressure stable and allows her to care for her family. Her month’s supply costs just \$1.86—a small amount that changes lives. Because of your generosity, she and 489 others received the hypertension medicine they needed this month. Your support truly saves lives and gives hope every day.




VISION: Physically, relationally, and spiritually healthy people contributing to thriving families and strong communities as God designed and desires.

Mélanie, now a beautiful 20-year-old, lives with her mother, five brothers, and five sisters in Monnonvil, far from the clinic. Her life began with great fragility. As a child, she suffered severe malnutrition, fever, flu, skin rashes, and diarrhea. Her tiny body fought for survival. After many tests, she was admitted to the nutrition center, where for two long years she received daily care until she fully recovered.



She returned home and hadn't needed the clinic—until now. Recently, she came for a consultation to check her overall health and receive guidance for her wellbeing. Though she doesn't remember those early days, her mother often recalls how close she was to losing her. Seeing Mélanie today—strong, joyful, and full of hope—fills our hearts. Because of your generosity, this little girl who once fought for her life now has the chance to grow, dream, and embrace a bright future.



Carolinia, 14 years old, travels nearly six hours from Délices to reach the clinic. On a visit for pain, she met the chaplains and was deeply moved by their teachings, especially the story of the prodigal son. She prayed with them and received a Bible and a song book — gifts she had longed for. Filled with determination, she promised to return to church and grow in her faith. Tearfully, she thanked God for guiding her to the clinic, sharing that this encounter helped her reconnect with God and find her place in the church once again.

Dams, an 11-month-old from Guitton, lives with his grandmother, mother, brother, and sister. Sick with diarrhea, a sore throat, and loss of appetite, he was brought to our clinic. He received medicine for his throat and, at just 17 pounds, joined the Medika Mamba program to help him gain weight. At follow-up, he was healthy and weighed 20.5 pounds. His mother, filled with gratitude, said she might have lost him without this care. She thanked God and the team, and we are deeply grateful to donors who make these recoveries possible.
