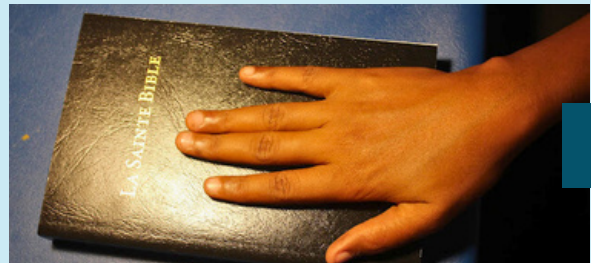

Claude, a bright 7-year-old boy, spent two and a half months in the clinic's nutrition center recovering from severe malnutrition. With consistent care and proper nutrition, his health and strength slowly returned. When he was well enough, he went back home to Lamy—a small town two hours away—where he now lives with his parents. Each month, Claude and his father walk back to the clinic for follow-up visits and food support. His father expresses deep gratitude for the care that helped his son regain health and hope for the future.

Fawens, a 9-month-old boy, arrived at the nutrition center weak and malnourished, suffering from diarrhea and swelling. After three months of care and proper nutrition, he's now healthy, strong, and full of energy. His favorite meal—rice with black bean sauce—helps him grow each day. Thank you for giving children like Fawens the chance for a brighter future.



Chrismailove, a 15-year-old girl from Rechimaud, suffered from persistent headaches for a long time. Her family tried different medicines and even sought help from people practicing magic, but nothing helped. After walking six hours to reach the clinic, Chrismailove met our chaplains, who comforted her and shared the message of Jesus. She decided to accept Christ into her life, trusting Him for healing. Since then, her headaches have stopped, and her heart is full of peace. Today, she joyfully participates in church again, grateful for her renewed faith and health.

Kervens, a two-year-old boy, was weak and underweight from diarrhea when his mother brought him to the clinic. With guidance from our staff and the mamba treatment you provided, she cared for him faithfully each day. Her dedication and love helped him regain strength and health. Today, Kervens is smiling, playing, and full of life again. Thank you for supporting mothers like his—your generosity gives families hope and children a chance to grow strong.

When 27-month-old Richardson arrived at the clinic, he was very weak and suffering from severe malnutrition, diarrhea, and fever. His mother, deeply worried, carried him from their village—determined to save her child. At the clinic, the nurses began treatment right away, giving him medicine and Medika Mamba, a peanut-based therapeutic food that helps malnourished children gain weight and strength. His mother also received guidance on how to continue his care at home.

Thanks to her dedication and the generous support of donors, Richardson's condition gradually improved. With regular follow-ups, his weight increased from 16 lb 5 oz to 22 lb 8 oz, and his energy and joy returned.

Stories like Richardson's remind us that every donation truly saves lives. Without your support, children like him would not have access to the food, medicine, and care they desperately need. Because of you, this little boy now has a healthy future and a grateful mother who knows she is not alone.



Thanks to your generosity, the clinic provides free Metformin—a vital treatment for people living with diabetes. One of them is Yollette, a 61-year-old mother from Cazale. Before coming to the clinic, she suffered from severe headaches, pain, and fatigue. Her first test showed a blood sugar level of 311. Since beginning treatment with Metformin and monthly follow-ups, her health has greatly improved. Five years later, Yollette's blood sugar has stabilized, and she now enjoys a healthier, more active life with her family. Your support gives her—and so many others—hope, strength, and the gift of continued life.

When 27-year-old Valérie from Cazale arrived at the clinic with severe stomach pain, she felt exhausted, anxious, and unsure of what was happening. As she waited to be seen, our chaplains came to speak with her. They listened with compassion, offered comfort, and shared hope through God's Word. Their kindness and encouragement touched her deeply, leading her to make peace with God and return to Him. Valérie says she now feels renewed—physically stronger and spiritually restored. Her story reminds us that Real Hope For Haiti brings healing not only for the body but also for the heart and soul.
