This resulted in a massacre in a small village that killed 42 people in early September. The main road was blocked for a week and a half. Please pray for peace and security to return. - Even with the instability and uncertainty, schools are scheduled to begin a new academic year in October. Pray the children going will be protected. Pray the environment will allow them to follow through and finish the school year. Please pray for struggling families trying to pay for school, and pray for those students RHFH sponsors that God would bless them with a year of growth.

- Prayers of praise that the Irish missionary who was kidnapped and we asked you to pray for in August was released unharmed. Thanks be to God!



- Pray for some aspiring medical professionals we received grants to help through school and training. Pray for them as they begin their school years as well. We are helping a medical school student, a physical therapy school student, a nursing student, as well as two social work students starting a program this year. Pray God would grant them understanding and the tools they are learning will make an impact in the future.
