- Pray for F.S., a young boy who broke his arm. His mom is asking God to help the operation to go well and for his arm to heal normally.
- Pray for L.T. who has a bone infection in his leg, that God would be merciful and help the surgery to resolve the issue and his leg would be healed and whole.
- Pray for A.F. who is suffering from hemorrhoids and a right leg/ foot that has hurt and limited mobility for two years. She is discouraged and asking the Lord to touch her and help her walk in victory.
- Pray for A.L. who was diagnosed with cancer in her throat. She is asking to agree with her in prayer that the power of God might touch and heal her.
- Pray for C.P. who has suffered from heartburn/ indigestion, digestive issues for 4 years, visiting many clinics and hospitals with no answers or solutions. Please pray for our staff coordinating her care to determine the cause, the best course for treatment, that God might heal her and relieve her pain and discomfort.
- Pray for E.S. as he senses a Satanic attack and that vodou curses have been put on him. He believes the power of God is stronger and desires prayer that God would protect him and deliver him from demonic oppression.
- Pray for A.V. who recently received Christ at the clinic after talking and praying with our chaplains. Pray she finds a healthy local church to connect with, the nearness of God would be a strength to her, and that she would grow and mature in her new faith. Praise God!



Our Work

- Pray for safe passage to Cap Haitien to get supplies. The issue of gang violence and road blockage nearest to us resolved some in September, but further up national route #1 near Montrouis and St Marc have had increasing tensions in October. Please pray for windows and opportunities for safe travel for our staff as they seek to keep the supply chain necessary for us to function.
- Pray for our staff as the gang in Cazale is putting more pressure on the clinic. Please pray for wisdom and guidance on how to navigate the ever-changing landscape here in Cazale.
- Pray for the GSF (Gang Suppression Force-UN) as they try to put together the financing and the resources to deploy them in Spring of 2026. While Haiti is enduring great hardship and dire circumstances, the earliest projected date for these forces to arrive in Haiti is not until April of 2026. Please pray for the Haitian National Police and Kenyans currently here as they attempt to stabilize the country and restore security.
- Pray for two doctors we have helped in medical school finish up their requirements and process all their paperwork (which is difficult in the current state of Haiti) in order to have their medical license in-hand.

Our Work



- Pray for local churches throughout the country of Haiti to remain faithful and strong, being bright lights during this dark season. With most all safety nets gone in-country, the local church has risen to the challenge. I am incredibly impressed with their resiliency and their sustained generosity, helping many displaced people in the last few years despite having limited resources themselves, often doing so in some of the most dangerous spots in Haiti.
- Pray for our staff to have boldness in proclaiming the Gospel of Christ. Pray for lives to be touched and hearts to be changed as a result of our witness for Christ in Cazale. Pray that gang members would be brought out of darkness and into His marvelous light.

Our Missionaries

- Pray for Lori and Charly as they labor in Cazale, amidst challenging circumstances and the presence of the gang. Pray that God would nourish them spiritually, give them deep rest, clear thinking, and the capacity to lead and communicate effectively to both patients and staff.
- Pray for Licia as she has been sick for some time. Pray solid rest would help her body recover and that the Lord, in His mercy, would make her whole again.
- Pray for Briana as her tuberculosis meds caused an alarming spike to some of her liver function tests. Her meds have been paused and her labs are improving. Pray her treatment can be completed and the tuberculosis to be gone.
- Pray for Casey and Briana's oldest daughter Grace, who turns 18 this month and is in the process of applying to university for the Fall of 2026. Please pray God open the right doors for her, connects her to the right people, plants her in the right school, and grants her courage to step out in faith to new beginnings.
