Kendy is a young guy with a huge heart for God. He's not the kind of person who sits around waiting for things to happen — he goes out and shares his faith wherever he can. Sometimes that means walking six or even eight hours to reach small, remote villages. He doesn't have much, but he has faith and a passion to tell people about Jesus. After each visit, he writes Bible verses on little scraps of paper and gives them away so people can keep God's Word close. One day, a clinic chaplain saw what he was doing and gave him a box of Gospel brochures to share. Kendy was so grateful — and he's still out there spreading hope and God's love.

Marthe, 48, suffered for years with headaches and pain, thinking it was from an old accident. When she finally visited the clinic, she learned her real issue was dangerously high blood pressure. With gentle guidance and free Enalapril provided by donors, she began treatment. Today, she feels stronger and deeply grateful for renewed health.



As Djolensky's Hope parent, I want to share a little of what his days look like with our family. Each morning, we bathe him, dress him in clean clothes, and make sure he has a good meal before heading to school. He comes home smiling, full of stories from his day—playing, learning, and laughing with his classmates. At home, we give him the love, stability, and security every child deserves. We pray with him, show him affection, and remind him that he is valued and cherished. Watching him grow healthy and confident is one of our greatest joys. Neica, an 8-year-old from Beilac, lives with her parents in a small stone house roofed with tin. When she came to the clinic, she had swelling and painful skin rashes on her body and scalp. With treatment and consistent monthly follow-ups, she steadily improved. Today, the swelling is gone, her skin is healed, and her weight is in the median range. Her mother is grateful to the medical team and to the PNS donors whose generosity made her recovery possible.

Eight-month-old Naylens lives with his mother, brother, and sister in Cabaret. Reaching care meant an hour-long motorcycle taxi ride to our nutrition center. When he arrived, his condition was critical—severe malnutrition, swelling, fever, and painful sores. Our clinic team began treatment immediately with medications, therapeutic milk, and Medika Mamba. Because of your generosity, Naylens is already getting stronger. The swelling has gone down, he's gaining weight, and his appetite has returned—he especially loves chicken and bean sauce. These changes are small miracles made possible by faithful support. As our year-end appeal comes to a close, we want to say thank you. This December, we've been praying for 31 new Anchors of Hope—monthly donors who stand with us so care is there the moment a child arrives. Looking ahead to the new year, we are deeply encouraged by those who have stepped forward. Your partnership brings hope, healing, and a future to children like Naylens.



Teiner is an 8-year-old boy who lives with his mom and six siblings. One day, he needed surgery, and when he came to the clinic, the medical team took care of him.
