- G.G. is a widowed mother who wants prayer for God to bless her children and open doors for them to have more opportunities in their lives.
- M.S. is a young lady needing prayer that God would provide dependable work in order that she would be able to provide for her family.



Our Work

- Please pray for continued tensions in the area of Bercy (near Cabaret). This is about 8 miles from Cazale and has been a point where existing gangs have been battling with authorities and local population. Cabaret is under the control of gangs and the next major town up National Route #1 is Arcahaie, which they have repeatedly attempted to attack and control. Bercy is a small village between the two that has become a dividing line of sorts. These skirmishes have closed the main road for weeks at a time and cut off our supply line north from Cap Haitien.
- Pray for our end of the year fundraiser launching December 1. Due to increased emergencies this year, getting people to larger medical facilities to get necessary operations we cannot provide, we have a current budget shortfall we need to meet to finish 2025 strong and enter into the new year of 2026 in a healthy financial position. We trust God's Provision and as you to join us in prayer He will provide for our needs.

Our Work

- Pray for the students we currently have enrolled in various schools, preparing to be doctors, nurses, physical therapists, and social workers. We are grateful to be able to help equip the next generation of medical professionals here in Haiti and are greatly anticipating the impact they will have through Real Hope for Haiti when they conclude their studies.
- Pray for some new nursery projects GVADK is starting back up. Despite the challenging season Haiti is enduring, we are thankful to be a part of a group that continue to work towards a better and more sustainable future.



- Pray for the announced upcoming election here in Haiti. We have not had a president since the assassination of Jovenel Moise in July 2021. The current state of instability in Haiti can be somewhat attributed to a lack of leadership and vision. The current security situation puts the feasibility of this announced election in doubt. Please pray the election would be able to take place, a strong leader with clear vision would emerge, and Haiti would begin to move forward.

- Pray for Abigail, who is taking college classes and is engaged to be married in early 2026.
- Pray for Charly and Lori, that God would grant them wisdom and discernment as they are in Haiti making the daily, difficult decisions that come with navigating these challenging times on the front lines.
- Pray for Briana as she was required to re-start her TB treatment with alternative medicines that should resolve the liver issues she had with the last medications. This course of treatment is 9 months long, and she has battled nausea the first week, so please pray God would be gracious and strengthen her along the way.
