Our Work

- Pray for the countries and soldiers that will be deployed to Haiti in the Gang Suppression Force, set to come to Haiti in 2026. Pray the details and coordination pre-deployment will come together well and avoid delays. Pray for their effectiveness in their strategic goals to establish peace again in Haiti and begin the rebuilding process after years of turmoil.
- Pray prayers of thanksgiving that three of the physicians we supported through medical school were able to graduate and walk this December despite the current realities and challenges in Haiti. We are proud of their efforts and commitment and look forward to their impact and how God will use them as a part of RHFH's ministry.
- Pray for the safety and security of all of those here in Cazale. The police began using drones to combat the gangs outside PAP in Minoterie (Lafiteau) near Titanyen recently, with a report of 38 killed on Christmas Eve. With the gang residing here in Cazale, this brings additional uncertainties to an already unstable situation.
- Pray that God's justice would be established. Pray RHFH can be peacemakers.
- Pray for those who responded to our Anchors of Hope challenge in December, for new recurring donors, and to all who faithfully give towards making the energy and efforts of RHFH effective, bringing much relief to those hurting and much glory to God.



- Pray for our chaplains who will begin to reach outside the walls of the clinic/ RC in 2026. They used to hold Bible Study classes for young people in the community, which we paused when security around Cazale began to deteriorate a few years ago. After prayerful consideration, our chaplains are eager to re-establish this ministry and service to the community. Pray they will be engaging and effective as they do. They are also planning to support and encourage local church leaders with a small conference in February.

- Pray for Abigail, who is set to be married in January 2026! Praise God!
- Pray for Briana as she is into her third iteration of tuberculosis treatment due to some issues with her liver function. The current medications are making her very nauseated and uncomfortable. Pray she finds a good rhythm and the God would be gracious to ease the side effects of this treatment, as she is required to be on this medication until August 2026.
- Pray for Lori as she remains in Haiti and Charly as he travels to FL in January.
- Pray for Casey as he participates in a retreat with the youth group and prepares to lead a session at a Family Conference at their home church in WA state.
- Pray for missionary child Grace Zachary as she hears back from various colleges and prayerfully considers where the Lord might lead to her continue her studies next Fall after she completes high school this Spring.
- Pray for Licia as she continues to work hard in Indiana to support the work in Haiti and manage her programs and staff there. Pray for her as she continues to travel around Indiana and represent RHFH at local churches that support us. Pray for her to have renewed strength after a particular busy month at her second job in Indiana that requires a significant amount of time and energy.
